Evaluation

Tender opening session

All the members of the evaluation committee signed the declaration of impartiality.

A bid register was prepared: the evaluation committee confirms that six (6) tenders have been received in sealed envelopes before the deadline 05/08/2026 at 4:30 PM sri lanka time. One offer was received the day after the tender closing date and, therefore, was not admitted for evaluation. The offer excluded as per late submission was : YUREMA COMPUTER

As this is an open local tender, on the 11th of August at 11:15 am the public opening session started, none of the tenderer were present. The evaluation committee checks the EDES database available at the following link: https://commission.europa.eu/strategy-and-policy/eu-budget/how-it-works/annual-lifecycle/implementation/anti-fraud-measures/edes/edes-database_en) and declares that none of the participants are excluded or subject to financial penalties by EU.

Administrative compliance

The evaluation committee used the administrative compliance grid to assess the compliance of each of the tenders with the administrative requirements of the tender dossier.

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The Evaluation Committee validated the completeness, validity, and formal compliance of N. 5 out of N. 6 offers, and confirm that all required administrative documents were duly provided in accordance with the provisions of the Tender Dossier. The administrative documentation of SINGHAGIRI was not in compliance with the tender requirements, as the only administrative document provided was the business registration. Therefore, it did not pass the administrative evaluation and consequently, it can't proceed to the technical evaluation phase

Technical compliance

The technical evaluation concerns the procurement, delivery, and assembly of electronic equipment for the Loyola Campuses in **Mullaitivu, Hatton, and Batticaloa**. The evaluation was carried out in accordance with the technical requirements and evaluation criteria set out in the tender documents. Each offer was assessed for its compliance with the required technical specifications, quality standards, and other requirements. Given that the procurement is divided into three (3) Lots, the technical evaluation was conducted separately for each Lot, corresponding to the respective delivery location:

- **Lot 1:** Loyola Campus Mullaitivu
- **Lot 2:** Loyola Campus Hatton
- **Lot 3:** Loyola Campus Batticaloa

Offers were considered technically compliant where they met the minimum technical requirements specified in the tender documents.

The technical evaluation was carried out using an evaluation grid:

The technical evaluation of the bids submitted by the bidders led to the following assessment. The table below indicates, for each bidder, whether the technical bid submitted was technically compliant with the requirements specified in the request for proposals.

Following the technical evaluation of the remaining offers, the Evaluation Committee notes that SBS OFFICE SOLUTION submitted a complete offer for Lot 3, including an interactive smart board meeting the dimensions specified in the tender documents. Bidder OQURAA COMPUTER submitted complete offers for all the 3 Lots. With regard to the interactive smart board proposed by bidder OQURAA COMPUTER, the Committee noted that its dimensions are slightly smaller than those specified in the technical requirements. However, following a detailed assessment of the technical characteristics, functionality and intended use of the proposed equipment, the Committee considers that this deviation is minor and does not materially affect the functionality, performance or intended purpose of the equipment, nor does it compromise the objectives of the procurement.

Taking into consideration the above assessment and subject to the applicable procurement rules, the Evaluation Committee recommends awarding the Lot 2 to SBS OFFICE SOLUTION, that has submitted a fully compliant offer; while recommending the award of the remaining Lots 1 and 3 to OQURAA COMPUTER, whose offers are otherwise technically acceptable and whose identified deviation concerning the dimensions of the interactive smart board is considered non-material. This recommendation is made on the basis of the technical evaluation of each offer and lot, taking into account the completeness of the offers, compliance with the applicable technical requirements and the materiality of the identified deviation.

Accordingly, the Evaluation Committee recommends proceeding with the evaluation of the compliant items and, subject to the applicable procurement rules and the overall assessment of the bids, recommends the following:

Financial evaluation

Determination of the amount of the financial offers

The Evaluation Committee reviewed the technically compliant tenders and verified the financial offers for arithmetic errors and discrepancies. During this review, it was noted that SBS OFFICE SOLUTION had priced two (2) Bluetooth Portable Speakers with microphone and mixer, whereas the tender documents required only one (1) unit.

Accordingly, the financial offer was adjusted to reflect the quantity specified in the tender documents.

Conclusion

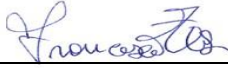
